There is a 12-month time limit per application. If you weren't selected within 12 months of applying, you have to apply again if you still wish to rent a studio. High artistic quality along with a documented professional practice is the primary criteria for the selection of studio spaces. Studios are distributed to qualified applicants in regards to suitability for artistic work and available studio space. We strive for diversity in regard to artistic expressions, ethnicity, age and gender. Applicants have to be registered in Gothenburg or in the bordering geographical areas to Gothenburg. The artist is required to actively use the studio as their primary workspace. The selected artists are required to take part in the community organization duties.
